Rumor is my 10 year old Miniature Schnauzer. Three years ago she was starting to scratch her back. She would reach to bite her back with such force that she would put her back out. She was in so much pain she had to be put on Metacam daily. The vet also had to put her on Vancetel P. to keep the itching down. This did not stop the itching but did slow it down.
